PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Construction of approximately 50 OFCAs on 49 sites, ranging from 4” to 16” in size, in Southern Sacramento County. Includes piping and appurtenances, site grading, construction of farm roads, culverts (as needed), fencing, and electrical equipment.

Cost: No cost; registration is required to access and download contract documents.

A mandatory pre-bid conference and walk-through will be held for the purpose of reviewing and answering questions regarding this project. Attendees must e-mail OFCA@SacSewer.com with attendee names no later than 3 days prior to the mandatory pre-bid conference and walk-through date. This information is required to provide access at the EchoWater Resource Recovery Facility's (EchoWater Facility) security gate. Representatives of the Sacramento Area Sewer District (District) and the Design Consultant will be present for questions.

Award of this Contract requires a valid California contractor's license with the classification identified above.

Each bid must be submitted on the bid forms provided in the Contract Documents. Each bid must also be accompanied by security of not less than ten percent (10%) of the aggregate sum of the bid and no bid will be considered without it. The bid security may be in the form of, a certified check or cashier's check payable to the Sacramento Area Sewer District, or a bid bond issued by a qualified corporate surety licensed to do business in California and must be submitted using the form in BID SECURITY FORM Section (00 43 13). If a bid bond is utilized as the security, a current and effective power of attorney evidencing the authority of the officer, agent or representative who executed the bid bond on behalf of surety to execute, seal and deliver such bid bond must be included.

The successful bidder shall be required to execute a Material and Labor Payment Bond and Performance Bond, issued by a corporate surety, acceptable to the Sacramento Area Sewer District, each for not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price.

Pursuant to Section 22300 et seq. of the Public Contract Code, Contractor may, at its own expense, either substitute securities for any money being withheld by the District or request payment of retention earned directly to a state or federally chartered bank as escrow agent to ensure performance under this contract.

Statements of experience shall be submitted by the three (3) apparent low bidders to Contract Services, 10060 Goethe Road, Sacramento, CA 95827 within seven (7) days following the opening of bids. The required experience statements are as follows:

1. The General Contractor, construction experience of similar magnitude and character to that contemplated under this contract.

2. Those subcontractors listed in the Designation of Subcontractors, construction experience of similar magnitude and character to that contemplated under this contract.

No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].

No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5.

LABOR COMPLIANCE PROGRAM: The County of Sacramento received final approval from the Director of California Department of Industrial Relations as a Labor Compliance Program effective March 15, 1994. All questions regarding this Labor Compliance Program and prevailing wage requirements should be directed to the Labor Compliance Section at (916) 875-2711.

Pursuant to California Labor Code Section 1720 and following, and Section 1770 and following, the successful bidder shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. Copies of the prevailing wage determinations are on file at the office of the County of Sacramento Labor Compliance Program, 9700 Goethe Road, Suite D, Sacramento, CA 95827, and are also available on the internet at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR/PWD>.

The Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informality in any bid, and to determine which bid, in the judgment of the Board, is the lowest responsive bid of a responsible bidder.
