RFP#8512 On Call Sewer Cleaning and CCTV Services

Question #1

In the sample project costs, what percent clean are we to assume the pipes should be during cleaning work? (both for the laterals and pipes?)

Response #1

SacSewer's TVI manual Section 201.2 "Defect Ratings" discusses severity ratings. The Contractor can assume the pipe has moderate grease/solids/debris, and up to #6 roots.

Question #2

In the vendor questionnaire, you reference CIPP/Pipe bursting on page 33. I'm assuming that should say CCTV and cleaning.

Response #2

Correct, please see addendum #2.

Question #3

Please confirm the yearly value of expected work, (Page 2 appears to have a typo) estimated cost of \$800,000 million per year)?

Response #3

Clarified to \$800,000 dollars, not \$800 million. Please see addendum #1 attached.

Question #4

Although not referenced, please confirm that NO Bid Bond is necessary to be submitted along with the RFP?

Response #4

Correct, this is a proposal, no bid bond required.

Question #5

Vendor Questionnaire - Section 2 References (Page 33), asks for three or more clients for CIPP or Pipe Bursting services. Please confirm if this is a typographic error since the RFP is for Cleaning & CCTV work?

Response #5

Correct, please see addendum #2.

Question #6

Please confirm under Scope of Work Item 6 Sewer Lower Lateral CCTV Inspection (Page 15) that all Lower Laterals are accessible via a Manhole, Flushing Branch or Cleanout and that a lateral launcher is not required for the inspection?

Response #6

It is assumed the laterals will be accessible and a lateral launcher is not required.

Question #7

Please confirm that under Specifications Item 11 Unit Prices (Page 17) if the provided Unit Prices from the RFP will be utilized for actual bids issued under future solicitations from the selected Contractors?

Response #7

The unit prices will be used to rank each contractor. The unit prices will act as a reference for SacSewer when receiving bids from selected contractors. Each bid package solicited will include a bid item sheet where the Contractor can fill the appropriate unit prices based on the project being bid.

Question #8

Under the various sections of the Vendor Price Proposal (Pages 38-42) in addition to the provided assumptions, can SacSewer provide any assumed minimum call out quantities per mobilization to aid the Contractor in developing an accurate Unit Price?

Response #8

We are unsure what is being asked.

Question #9

Vendor Price Proposal – Inspecting Main Lines using CCTV (Page 40) under assumptions discussing Main Lines are to be pipe burst from manhole to manhole. Please confirm no Pipe bursting work is contemplated under this RFP?

Response #9

No pipe bursting. This assumption is an oversight and can be struck from the item. Please see addendum #2.

Question #10

Please review and confirm that under Vendor Price Proposal for Inspecting Manholes using CCTV (Page 42) bid item description #1 & 2 should be labeled Inspect MH using CCTV and the reference to main line is a typographic error?

Response #10

Yes this is an error, it should be manholes not main lines. Please see addendum #2.

Question #11

Please review and confirm that under Vendor Price Proposal for Inspecting Manholes using CCTV (Page 42) bid item #2 Unit should be labeled EA and that ES is a typographic error?

Response #11

Yes this should be fixed. It should be EA under item 2. Please see addendum #2.
